The Corporation is involved in all aspects of the petroleum supply chain covering the upstream oil and gas exploration, midstream petroleum infrastructure development and downstream marketing of petroleum products.

National Oil Corporation intends to undertake the rehabilitation, upgrading and recommissioning of its Nairobi Fuel Terminal and LPG Plant to improve operational efficiency, safety, environmental compliance, reliability and storage capacity. The Nairobi National Terminal is a National Oil white products depot located off Nanyuki Road in Industrial Area, Nairobi.

The project comprises, but is not limited to:

- Rehabilitation of petroleum storage tanks
- Rehabilitation and upgrading of loading gantries
- Product pipeline modifications
- Fire protection systems
- Electrical systems
- Instrumentation and automation
- SCADA systems
- Tank gauging

National Oil Corporation is therefore inviting Expressions of Interest (EOI) from qualified consultancy firms to provide consultancy services for rehabilitation, upgrading and recommissioning of its Nairobi Fuel Terminal and LPG Plant.

Firms participating in the EOI are required to submit the following documents and/or copies of the same:-

- i) Demonstration of financial capability in carrying out the required consultancy services by attaching certified copies of the firm's audited accounts for the last three year (2023, 2024 and 2025) with an average Annual Turnover of at least Kshs **40 million**.
- j) Evidence of practical experience in undertaking Consultancy Services for Rehabilitation, Upgrading and Recommissioning of Fuel and Liquefied Petroleum Gas Terminals.
- k) Details of at least one (1) similar projects undertaken in the last 5 years.
- l) Summary of the proposed methodology and plan to be used once awarded the Consultancy.
