MWANANCHI GAS DISTRIBUTOR REQUIREMENTS

Background

The Government of Kenya working through the Ministry of Petroleum & Mining and National Oil Corporation is rolling out a National LPG enhancement project dubbed Mwananchi Gas Project. Under this project, 6Kg complete cylinders (gas, burner & grill), trading under the brand name "Gas Yetu", is being distributed at a discounted price of **Kshs 1,950** to households which would otherwise not afford. Besides the discounted program, the government through National Oil is developing a robust distribution model that will enable Kenyan citizens in all the counties access LPG at the nearest shopping center through licensed distributors and retailers.

2	Demonstrate logistical ability; a. 1 Truck of between 5 – 10MT (owned or leased) for purposes of own collection from the bottling plant at National Nairobi Terminal along Nanyuki Road and distribution to the end user – Provide a logbook or lease agreement b. Storage facility – sufficient to store a minimum of 500 cylinders – Proof of ownership or a tenancy agreement
